Church Changes

After much discussion amongst the leaders of the church, we have come to the decision to have our first church service in the building on Sunday, June 21 normal service times (9:15am & 11:00am). We will be enacting certain changes and regulations to church service in order to maintain a safe and healthy environment. However, we can't accomplish this without your assistance. With that said, we have listed the major changes we will be enacting for you to follow and understand. With the start of our first Sunday back, we recognize that a fair amount of you may not feel comfortable attending services quite yet. For those who decide not to attend immediately; we will still have pre recorded sermons available on our website, facebook and vimeo.

Touch Free Environment

We are striving to make the building as touch free as possible by propping the doors leading to the church and worship center open before service starts weather permitting. The bathroom doors will continue to stay closed due to privacy. There will be hand sanitizer in the bathrooms and throughout the building for everyone to regularly use. We ask that you refrain from shaking hands, hugging and other forms of contact. We also have a schedule to sanitize and wipe down any surfaces regularly touched before, during and after services. We ask that you limit any contact you have with the building and others as much as possible. Masks can be worn, but are not required.

Kids Services

We will not be providing a kids service at this time. It would be nearly impossible to keep children from touching things/others in such an enclosed space. If you bring your child, the nursery will be open to those that need to use it. It will be available for things like breastfeeding and changing diapers, but not available to drop your child off. There will be a volunteer to watch over that room and sanitize after each use.

Coffee Station

The coffee station and donut sunday will be temporarily closed due to open food containers. We ask that you provide your own coffee in the morning if necessary. The water fountains will be closed and shut off on Sundays as well. We will be providing 10oz water bottles that have been sanitized before service. We ask that you take what you touch and dispose of the bottle when you are done. Please do not return a water bottle if you decide that you do not want it. Take it with you for later.

Communion

Communion will not be prepared and served like normal. It will be prepackaged with two plastic coverings, separating the wafer and juice. It will be placed in the communion holder in front of every seat and can be used during the appropriate time. We ask that when you are finished, you throw your trash away in a receptacle at every exit of the worship room at the end of service. Again, we ask that you take what you touch and dispose of your trash yourself. Before each service we will be sanitizing each package of communion and the holder. We will also be placing a connection card on the back of each chair for people to fill out if they choose. If you complete the connection card there will be a place to drop it off at each exit of the worship room after service.

Bibles

There will be a table with Bibles on it at the main entrance of the worship room. These are for you to use during service and/or take with you. They will be available to grab before service starts and will be covered after service begins. We ask that you either take this Bible with you or return it to a separate table as you exit so we can sanitize them before the next person uses it. Bringing your own personal Bible is highly encouraged.

Bulletin

We will not be providing a bulletin for service. If you would like to take notes on the service, please bring your own paper/notebook. Pens will be available at the main entrance to the worship room. We ask that you do not return the pen after you use it. All events will be advertised on the screens in the family room, through our newsletter, and our website. We will be placing a connection card on the back of each chair for people to fill out if they choose. If you complete the connection card there will be a place to drop it off at each exit of the worship room after service.

If you wish to know more about what the church will be doing to keep the building clean and safe, read below for a brief list of our schedule.
